Comments from the CEO

Good order intake for the quarter

We had a good order intake quarter of SEK 100 (53) million, which is almost 90 percent higher than the order intake in Q1 2018. Major contributors to this order intake were a large in-vehicle order from our key customer in Australia and extensions of Managed Services contracts with existing customers in the USA. The recurring nature of the total order value amounts to 36 percent.

Traffic Enforcement as a Service

In our 2018 annual report we emphasized our strategic focus on recurring revenue. To create a better understanding for our customers we introduced Traffic Enforcement as a Service. With TRaaS, as we call it, we will bring our new FLUX platform for hardware and our existing software solutions PULS and Xilium together. TRaaS provides complete flexible service solutions for our customers, all around the world.

Delayed deliveries due to fire at supplier

We closed the financial year 2018 with a high total order intake value of SEK 480 million. In December 2018 a fire at our supplier Prodrive resulted in delays in deliveries of our T-series products. Due to the fire, the sales level of SEK 78 (72) million is lower than we would have seen with supply at normal delivery timelines, but 8% higher than the same quarter last year.

Supply is picking up in Q2

The situation at this supplier is now in control and as of April the supply is picking up again. We expect that the negative impact of the delayed deliveries on our revenues in the first quarter, will mostly be recovered in the second quarter.

Oklahoma learning curve

A major breakthrough for our Managed Services business in 2018 was the starting up of a car insurance enforcement program in the state of Oklahoma, USA. Being a completely new program for the US market, which involves multiple third party stakeholders, the Oklahoma project is going through a learning curve, resulting in some delays. We still expect the program to deliver the announced full year revenue of SEK 17 million. The impact of Oklahoma is the main reason why our Managed Services sales in the quarter of SEK 18 (11) million is below our expectations, but 60% higher than last years sales in the segment.

Available cash and financial position

Our available cash has decreased from SEK 153 million to SEK 127 million. This is mainly due to prepayments received in 2018 on various projects, which have been delivered in part in the first quarter. Simultaneously we have build up contract assets, work in progress, relating to projects, impacting our working capital negative. Due to adaptation of the new accounting standard IFRS 16 we have seen a decrease in our Equity/Assets ratio from 71.8 at the end of 2018 to 66.2. Our financial position remains solid.



Outlook

With our new Traffic Enforcement as a Service proposition, we strengthen our position to establish long term customer relationships and to increase our recurring revenue potential going forward. Due to the recovery program at our supplier Prodrive we anticipate no impact on the full year deliveries. Considering our good order intake we feel optimistic about the future.

Financial results Group



January - March 2019

Order intake during the first quarter totalled SEK 100.0 million compared to SEK 52.8 million, excluding SEK 122.0 million in procurement awards, in the same quarter last year. The order intake for the quarter mainly relates to orders received from our customers in Australia and USA, amongst other smaller repeat orders.

Net sales in the first quarter, amounted to SEK 78.4 million (71.7) and consisted primarily of deliveries and services to customers in Europe and various smaller orders from existing customers globally. The segment System Sales contributed SEK 61.5 million (62.2) and Managed Services contributed SEK 17.6 million (10.6) to the net sales of the first quarter including inter-segment transactions.

Of the total sales in the quarter approximately 46 percent relates to recurring revenues based on Service & Maintenance, License and Managed Services revenue, compared to 37 percent for the full year 2018. The increase is due to a relative lower System Sales in the period. To support our focus on recurring revenue, we have renamed all our recurring revenues categories to TRaaS, see table below.

The gross margin for the quarter was 37.2 percent (34.9). The increase in gross margin compared to the first quarter 2018 is due to the mix in sales between the System Sales and Managed Services segments.

The operating expenses totalled SEK 41.3 million (39.9) including amortisation of intangible fixed assets recognized as part of the acquisition to the amount of SEK 5.8 million (5.4).

The operating profit for the quarter totalled SEK -12.1 million (-14.9) and the profit after taxation totalled SEK -9.5 million (-13.1).

Investments

During the first quarter 2019 the investments in fixed assets amounted to SEK 4.8 million (4.5) of which SEK 1.5 million (0.3) relates to intangible fixed assets. The investments in intangible fixed assets mainly relates to the continued development of our FLUX platform.

As a consequence of the implementation of IFRS 16 as of January 1, 2019 costs relating to rent and lease of buildings and other assets have been capitalized on the balance sheet in their respective categories (Right of use Assets). The liabilities have been recorded under the long-term borrowings as Lease liabilities. The short-term part of these liabilities have been presented under the short-term borrowings. The impact of IFRS 16 amounts to an increase in assets and liabilities to the amount of SEK 38.6 million.

Personnel

The average number of full-time employees was 178 people (153). The number of employees at the end of the year was 210 to be compared with 195 at the end of the financial year 2018. The increase in employees is mainly due to processing staff in the USA, relating to on-boarding of new programs and project temps in Australia relating to the execution of the various projects that were announced in 2018.



Financial position

The Group's equity at the end of the period totalled SEK 451.6 million (418.4), producing an equity/assets ratio of 66.2 percent (66.8). This ratio has been significantly impacted by the implementation of IFRS 16 in 2019, which is reflected in the short-term liabilities to the amount of SEK 9.3 million and in the Long-term liabilities to the amount of SEK 29.3 million.

Net interest-bearing debt amounted to SEK 49.6 million (28.1). The increase of the long-term liabilities is due to the implementation of IFRS 16. At the year end of 2018 the Net interest-bearing debt amounted negative SEK 17.7 million due to prepayments from customers, lower accounts payables and long-term liabilities.

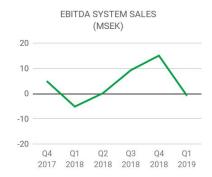


Business Segments

The two main segments used for internal reporting and managing the different operations are System Sales and Managed Services.







System Sales

The order intake for the segment Systems Sales amounted to SEK 70.6 million (SEK 5.0 million excluding procurement awards) in the quarter. The order intake mainly relates to orders from our customers in Australia and smaller repeat orders from our existing customers.

Systems sales amounted to SEK 61.4 million (61.0) in the quarter. Sales in the segment System Sales relates to one-off system sales and recurring revenue from service and maintenance. In this segment the service and maintenance sales provide a solid income evenly spread throughout the year. The one-off system sales in the first quarter relates mainly to systems sales in the regions Europe and Australia.

The segment has incurred an EBITDA of negative 0.8 million (-5.1) in the first quarter.









Managed Services

During the quarter we have been awarded with several contract extension worth SEK 33.5 million with contract periods between 1-3 years. After the period the segment has received a contract extension worth SEK 21.5 million over a five year contract period.

Managed Services sales amounted to SEK 17.6 million (10.6) in the quarter. The increase in sales is due to reactivation of the Iowa programs and the startup of new programs announced during the year. The segment has incurred an EBITDA of SEK 0.7 million (-0.8).

The segment Managed Services also includes software development costs relating Managed Services activities, such as PULS and Xilium, and the onboarding of several new programs.

Cash flow and financial position





Cash and available cash

Cash and cash equivalents at the end of the period totalled SEK 59.1 million (66.5). At the end of the period free available cash amounted SEK 127.1 million (121.8) taking into account the total amount of available credit facilities.

The group's credit facility agreements are subject to covenant clauses, whereby the group is required to meet certain financial ratios.

Cash flow from operating activities

During the quarter Sensys Gatso has had a negative cash flow from operating activities of SEK 20.6 million (3.5) in the first quarter of 2018. This is mainly due to prepayments received in 2018 on various projects, which have been delivered in part in the first quarter. Simultaneously we have build up contract assets (work in progress), relating to projects, this has resulted in higher working capital assets.

Cash flow from investing activities

The investments in fixed assets amounted to SEK 4.8 million (4.5) in the quarter.

Notes

General

Nature of operations

Sensys Gatso Group develops markets, sells and operates world-leading system solutions and products to improve traffic safety. Our largest product category includes automatic speed and red-light monitoring systems designed to prevent traffic accidents and thereby saving lives and social resources. All products are based on our unique, high precision, target-tracking radars offering high legal certainty. The market for traffic safety systems is a global niche market with healthy underlying growth.

EBITDA (Earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortization)

The Intangible fixed assets, relating to the Purchase Price Allocation on the acquisition of Gatso Beheer BV, generates considerable amounts of amortisation. Due to this, we believe that, in order to assist in understanding the operational business and growth, it is useful to consider EBITDA when assessing the financial performance.

Comparability of figures

As of 1 January 2019 IFRS16 has been implemented, impacting comparability of our financial performance. With IFRS16 the discounted value of future right of use of leased assets is recorded on the balance sheet as an asset with a corresponding lease liability. The asset is depreciated over time in accordance with the remaining lease period and the redemption of the liability is done through lease payments. The impact of discounting is recorded as an interest expense. Sensys Gatso Groups balance, profit and loss and cash flow is impacted by IFRS16 as follows:

Volatility

The Group's revenue is affected by the volatility of the System Sales business. Due to the variance in bigger and smaller contracts and the time at which opportunities rise, revenue can be affected significantly during a quarter. To assist in understanding the operational business and to get a better view of the Group's performance, we provide quarterly data over six quarters.

Risks and uncertainty

Significant risks and uncertainties faced by the group primarily consist of commercial risks associated with customers and suppliers, and financial risks in its international business due to changes in exchange- and interest rates, as well as liquidity, financing and credit risks. Currency risks also arise in the translation of foreign net assets and earnings. Sensys Gatso Group's overall goal is as far as possible to avoid taking financial risks that may arise through changes in foreign currency rates, interest levels and market prices, as well as liquidity, financing and credit risks.

For more information about the group's risks, please refer to note 24 of the 2018 Annual Report. There are not considered to be any significant risks in addition to these.

Accounting policies

Sensys Gatso Group applies International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) as endorsed by the EU. This interim report has been prepared in accordance with IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting and the Swedish Accounts Act.

The Parent Company's interim report was prepared in accordance with the Swedish Annual Accounts Act and the Swedish Financial Reporting Board's recommendation RFR 2 – Accounting for Legal Entities.

The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the previous financial year as presented in the annual report for 2018, with the exception of the adoption of the new standard IFRS 16.

New standards, amendments and interpretations applicable from January 1, 2019



IFRS 16 Leases was issued in 2016 to replace IAS 17 Leases and is required to be adopted by 2019. Sensys Gatso's has selected the modified retrospective approach as method for first time adoption of this new accounting standard. This means that the cumulative effect of initially applying the standard is recognised at the date of initial application and there is no restatement of comparative information. The implementation of IFRS 16 has an impact on the comparability of the figures in 2019 with previous years.

For calculating the IFRS16 value for the Right of Use Asset and corresponding Lease Liabilities we have excluded leases with a remaining period shorter than 12 months and leases with a total value smaller than SEK 50,000. The Incremental Borrowing Rate used to calculate the value of the Right of Use Asset and the corresponding Lease Liability is based on the category of lease asset, the duration of the contract and the region.
