

Sensys Gatso has received a procurement award for red-light and mobile speed enforcement in Malaysia worth SEK 14 million

Sensys Gatso received the first order under the procurement award for the first batch consisting of in-vehicle speed enforcement equipment, corresponding to SEK 1,8 million. The in-vehicle systems will be installed in Q4, 2020.

The Malaysian government has been looking for new innovative solutions to improve traffic safety and to enhance the evidence material for red-light offences and has chosen the proven Sensys Gatso solutions. The contract also includes supply, installation and maintenance of red-light systems which is the majority of the value of the contract. The red-light systems will be installed in 2021 and are a replacement for competitive systems.
